### Mid-Year Reports

Year 1 - 3 students are reported on using an anniversary cycle that is calculated from the day they start school at CMcK with each child receiving two written reports per year. Year 4 - Year 8 also receive two written reports throughout the year and will be receiving their full mid-year report during Week 10. This report covers all learning areas and gives suggestions for ways to be further involved in your child's learning journey at home. This year we have added the word "Working" before the national standards interim judgement to indicate that this reflects the level of progress attained at the middle of the school year. Included in the report is a feedback form and information on how to book a follow-up interview with your child's teacher should you wish to do so. Follow-up interviews will be held during Week 1 and 2 of Term 3.

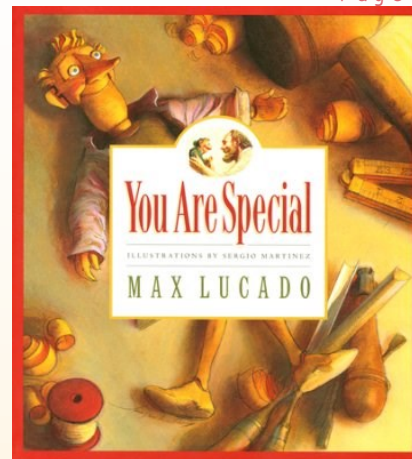
