Talent Assembly Week 10 Term 3

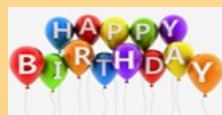

Emergency Kits

We have only had 50% of the Emergency kits delivered to the school. In the case of a Civil Defence Emergency we keep a small amount of emergency food and supplies at school that could cater for up to 20 people who are unable to reach their homes within the first 24 hours after an event.

We ask that each student brings for storage at school, a small personal “*emergency kit*” in the form of a named plastic ice-cream container (2 litre). This is for the children to use while waiting to be picked up.

Suggested items for the kit are:

- A few small meal tins
- A few small tins of fruit
- Energy bars
- Dried foods
- 1 plastic spoon/fork
- Small packet of tissues
- A disposable face mask
- 4 (supermarket size) plastic bags
- 1 litre bottle of water.

(please ensure best before dates are current on all food items)
