### Catholic Character

Through our newsletter during Term 2 we will focus on deepening our understanding of the Beatitudes – the instructions for being an active Church member that Jesus shared with us during the Sermon on the Mount. The concept of Church is described best by the verse from Mathew 18:20



For where two or three gather together in My name, there am I with them.” Therefore Church is not a building but a gathering of people who believe in God.

The exact site of the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-7:28) is unknown. Pilgrims commemorate the event at the eight-sided Church of the Beatitudes, built on the slope of the mount and accessible by a side road branching off the Tiberias-Rosh Pina highway.

The Mount of Beatitudes is also understood to be the place where Jesus met his apostles after his Resurrection and commissioned them to “make disciples of all nations” (Matthew 28:16-20).

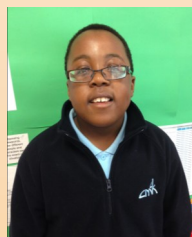
### Invitation

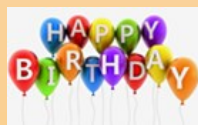
