### Kia ora te whānau, Catholic Character The Fruits of the Holy Spirit

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit is a way to describe the nine characteristics of a person or community living in harmony with the Holy Spirit, and can be found in chapter 5 of the Epistle to the Galatians:

**Charity (or Love)** Charity is the love of God and of neighbour, without any thought of receiving something in return.

**Joy** is the state of being undisturbed by the negative things in life.

**Peace** is a tranquillity in our soul that comes from relying on God, trusting God to provide for us.

**Patience** is the ability to bear the imperfections of other people, through a knowledge of our own imperfections and our need for God's mercy and forgiveness.

**Kindness** is the willingness to give to others above and beyond.

**Goodness** is the embrace of what's right, even at the expense of ones earthly fame and fortune.

**Gentleness** is to be forgiving rather than angry, gracious rather than vengeful.

**Faithfulness** means living our life in accordance with God's will at all times.

**Self-Control** is the exercise of moderation in all things.

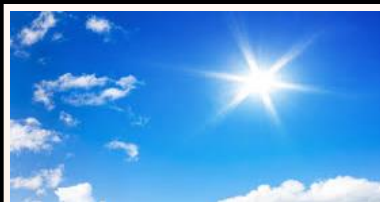

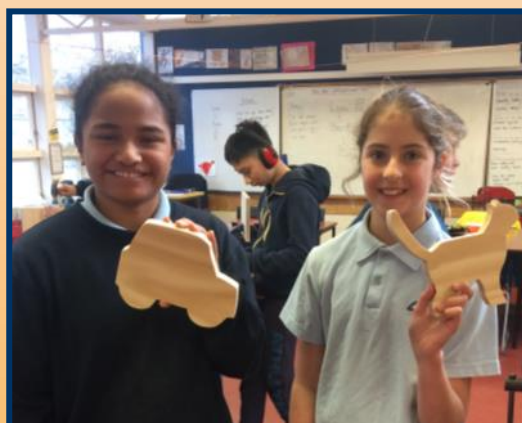
